The Teachers Training College Aalo organized college level Red Ribbon club Marathon under the theme “Run for Health, run for awareness”, this event spread awareness on HIV/AIDS prevention and healthy living.

The Marathon saw enthusiastic participation from approximately 100 participants across the categories, girls, boys and general, reflecting unity and diversity.
